Ulmus americana 'UASNZ'

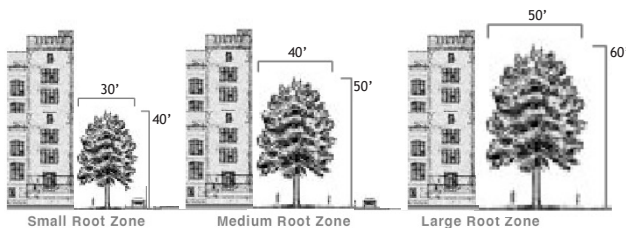
