Betula nigra 'BNMTF'

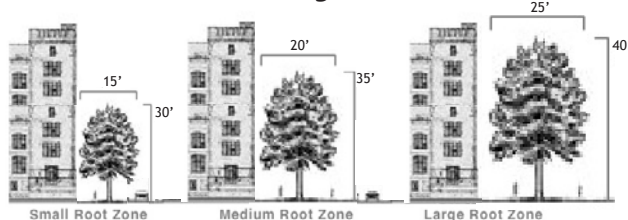

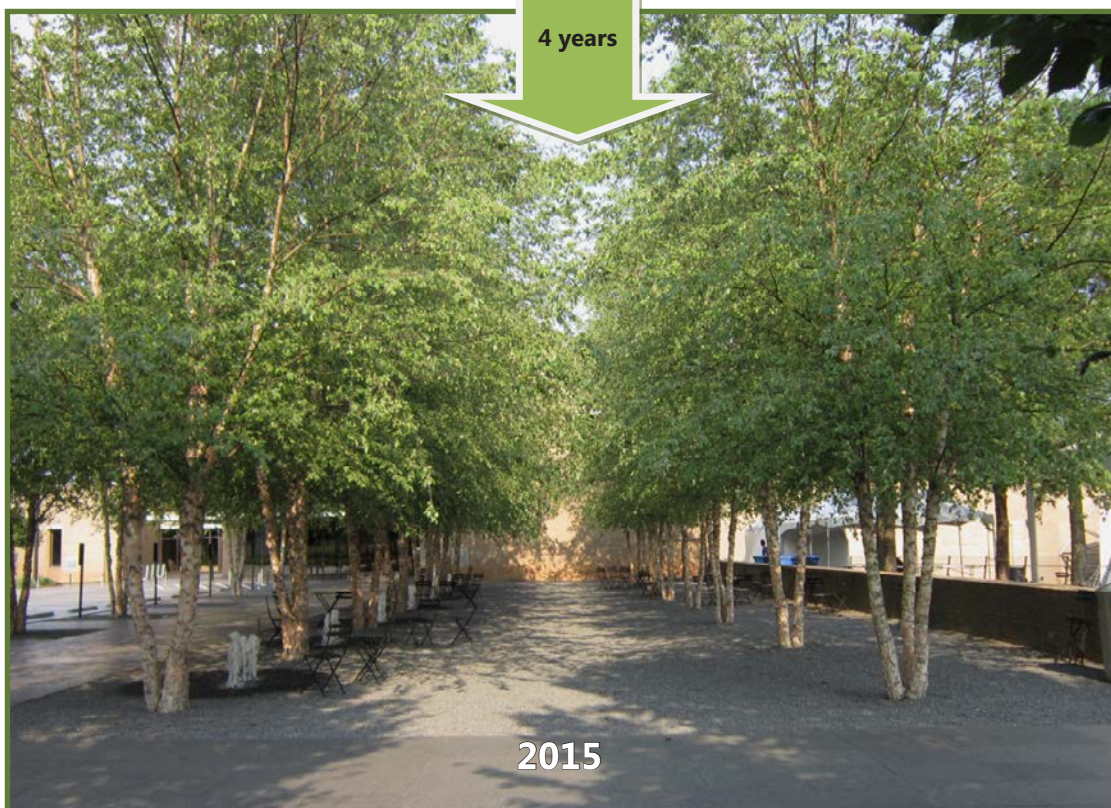
