

## **Endurance™ Compton Oak**


## Quercus x comptoniae 'QCE295' P.P.A.F.

Native shade tree - own root. Endurance<sup>™</sup> is the first clonal Compton Oak available on its own root. Compton is a unique natural hybrid between Live Oak (*Q. virginiana*) and Overcup Oak (*Q. lyrata*), both noted to be among the toughest trees for urban environments. Compton Oak was first named by Mrs. Compton of Natchez, Mississippi in the early 1900's. Endurance<sup>™</sup> is a vigorous selection and embodies traits of both its parents with great tolerance to many soil types and once established, very drought-tolerant.
