Osmanthus x fortunei 'Fruitlandii'

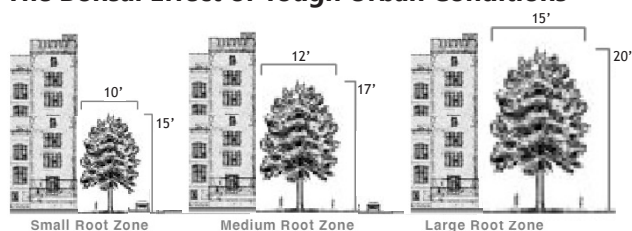
